Oral medicine (sometimes termed **dental medicine**, **oral and maxillofacial medicine** or **stomatology**) is a specialty focused on the mouth and nearby structures. It lies at the interface between medicine and dentistry.

Oral medicine is concerned with **clinical diagnosis and non-surgical management of non-dental pathologies** affecting the orofacial region (the **mouth and the lower face**). ○

Many **systemic diseases** have **signs or symptoms** that manifest in the orofacial region. ○
Pathologically, the mouth may be afflicted by many **cutaneous** and **gastrointestinal** conditions.

Example conditions that oral medicine is concerned with are **lichen planus**, **Behçet's disease** and **pemphigus vulgaris**. Moreover, it involves the diagnosis and follow-up of pre-malignant lesions of the oral cavity, such as **leukoplakias** or **erythroplakias** and of chronic and acute pain conditions such as **paroxysmal neuralgias**, **continuous neuralgias**, **myofascial pain**, **atypical facial pain**, **headaches** and **migraines**. ○

Another aspect of the field is **managing the dental and oral condition of medically compromised patients** such as cancer patients suffering from related **oral mucositis**, **bisphosphonate-related osteonecrosis** of the jaws or oral pathology related to radiation therapy. ○

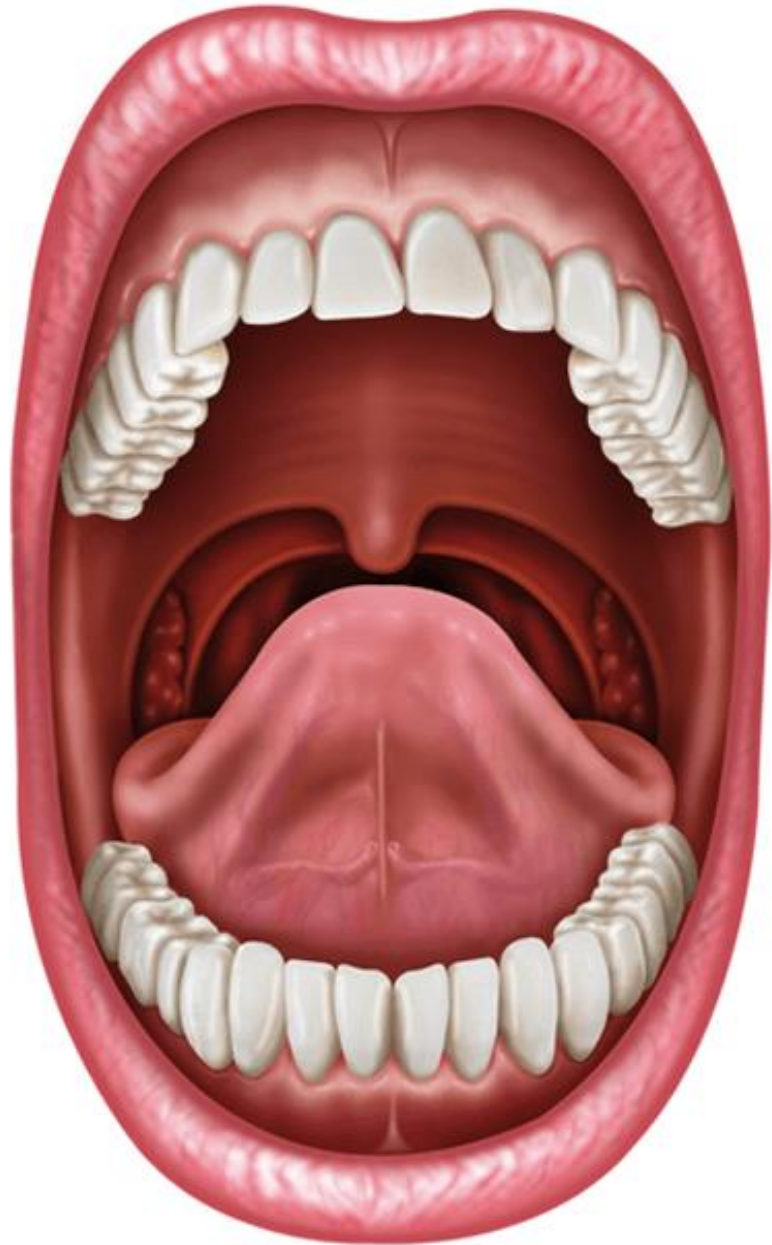
Additionally, it is involved in the diagnosis and management of **dry mouth** conditions (such as Sjögren's syndrome) and **non-dental chronic orofacial pain**, such as **burning mouth syndrome**, **trigeminal neuralgia** and **temporomandibular joint disorder**. ○





The overall objective of the teaching clinic is to emphasize the responsibility of dental students in obtaining a thorough medical and dental history, performing a comprehensive head and neck and oral examination, and to obtain appropriate consultation for their patients. The goal of the history and examination is to obtain vital information on medical and oral status, to promote early diagnosis.

Clinic rotation will promote appropriate treatment planning and to understand the role of oral and general health for the patient and to facilitate appropriate and safe dental care for patients.

Additionally, a focus on an understanding of the principles of diagnosis and treatment of oral soft tissue disease in medically complex and non-medically complex patients; orofacial sensory disorders and pain; movement disorders including TMD; salivary gland disease and oral manifestations of systemic disease; and medical management will be emphasized.

The Division of Oral Medicine at Tufts University School of Dental Medicine provides comprehensive oral health care for patients with medically-related disorders of the oral and maxillofacial region.

Services

Our providers serve in the interface between dentistry and medicine, diagnosing and managing diseases and conditions that involve the salivary glands and oral mucosa. These include:

- Acute and chronic oral lesions (e.g. infections, mucocutaneous disorders, cancer and pre-malignant lesions)
